



Land and Trail Steward

Description of Position: Stewards may adopt a section of trail or serve as floating volunteers. They perform basic trail maintenance functions including trimming, simple boardwalk repair, removing debris and sign replacement or installment. Trail maintenance will be conducted using a variety of hand tools which require training on how to properly and safely use the tools. The land and trail steward may work independently or assist staff with larger stewardship projects. All completed work and hours logged must be documented and reported to the GRNA Facilities and Land Steward.

Qualifications

- Ability to walk various distances over uneven surfaces and boardwalks
- Ability to walk in varied temperatures
- Ability to learn and use a variety of hand tools
- Ability to work unsupervised
- Ability to communicate both orally and in writing to GRNA staff and the general public

Required before starting service

- Complete Volunteer Information Form
- Volunteer Orientation
- Volunteer Training
- Walk through adopted section with Volunteer Coordinator or Stewardship Coordinator

Reports to: Volunteer Coordinator but works closely with the Land and Facilities Steward
