



Trail Monitor

Description of Position: Trail monitors adopt a section of trail and then monitor and report trail conditions and hours logged on a regular basis. Reports may include issues such as trees down, trail impediments, broken boardwalks or missing signs. This position also includes answering questions and providing information to visitors, observing visitor use patterns and documenting any noxious or invasive plant species.

Qualifications

Ability to walk various distances over uneven surfaces and boardwalks

Ability to work in varied temperatures

Good observation and reporting techniques

Ability to work unsupervised

Ability to communicate both orally and in writing with GRNA staff and the general public

Required before starting service

Reports to: Volunteer Coordinator but works closely with the Land and Facilities Steward
