



## **Outreach Volunteer**

**Description of Position:** Outreach Volunteers assist staff and/or other volunteers at off-site community events such as fairs, festivals and other community gatherings. The primary role of the Outreach Volunteer is to interact with the public about who GRNA is and what we do. This may also include helping to set up and take down the table, tent and displays and being able to handle the table independently. Outreach Volunteers must be comfortable talking with others about what GRNA does and be up to date on upcoming programs and events as well as the GRNA trail system and nature center.

### **Qualifications**

Knowledge of GRNA, who we are, what we do and how to get involved  
Comfortable communicating in a social setting with all ages  
Interest in researching fun and creative ways to engage the public  
Ability to a table or booth at an event, possibly standing for long periods of time  
Ability to communicate both orally and in writing to GRNA staff and the general public
